For over 150 years, the Episcopal Church in Jerusalem and the Middle East has borne, in a special way, the responsibility of sharing the cross of Jesus.

By helping to maintain the Christian witness in the Holy Land, by serving all of God's People there in a variety of ministries throughout the four dioceses, by proclaiming the gospel and promoting justice, peace and love, the church serves us all.

Since 1922, Anglicans here have supported the ministries of the Episcopal Church in Jerusalem and the Middle East through the **Good Friday Offering**. It is vital that we continue to share in this burden, and not let our brothers and sisters in Jerusalem carry the cross alone.
